4-H EDUCATIONAL POSTERS

Location: Posters are displayed throughout the Fairgrounds.

Rules and Instructions:

- Poster judging will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 10th at the Skagit Valley College Community room.
- School Farm posters may be displayed in the Marie Boe 4-H Building.
- Individual 4-H members are encouraged to enter Educational Posters in their 4-H project areas. Posters may show any topic of an educational or 4-H promotional nature. A member may enter one poster per project area that they are enrolled in. Posters must be a minimum 14x22 and a maximum of 22x28 inches, and may not include copyrighted illustrations or cartoons.
- All work must be done by the member. Adults can only give suggestions and advise.
- Demonstration Posters will NOT be accepted as Ed Posters.
- Posters will be divided into two categories: Class A- Technology Assisted: Posters that include any computer-generated clip art or lettering, photographs, stencil use, or any other art medium that is not the student's original handwork, and Class B- Original: Posters with artwork and lettering drawn entirely in the student's own hand. No stickers, stencils, photo's, clip art etc.
- Exhibitor's name should be put on back of poster. All posters will be entered on the Animal/Still Life Entry form in this premium book.
- Arrangements should be made to deliver posters to the Marie Boe 4-H Building on the Fairgrounds Sunday, August 9th between 2:00 and 5:00. Posters may also be delivered to the Extension Office anytime prior to Sunday August 9th, and all posters must be submitted (properly tagged) prior to judging time. Posters will not be accepted after 8 AM Monday, August 10th.
- Posters may be picked up for displaying in the barns on Tuesday of Fair week from the Marie Boe 4-H Building when available.
- Informational value is enhanced by: having one main idea, presenting accurate, timely, concise information by way of a clear brief message that is important and appropriate. Design is enhanced by one center of interest and a poster that attracts and holds interest. The poster should show imagination, and present a neat, simple and orderly appearance.
- Remember, if posters do not meet requirements, a participation ribbon will be issued, but no premium monies.
- Scorecard # C0679 is used to judge Educational Posters/4-H Promotional Posters.
