Ribbons will be awarded for both Professional and Non-Professional divisions.

**Rules:**

1. Entrants must be 16 years or older.
2. There will be a Young Adult Division for entrants 16 to 21 years (please note age on entry form).
3. A total of four entries per crafter will be accepted if the dimensions of each exhibit does not exceed 16x20 inches. Crafter may enter one larger sized exhibit in lieu of 2 or more legal size pieces.
4. All entries must be the original work of the crafter.
5. Any exhibit deemed unworthy will not be accepted or judged. Decision of the superintendent is final.
6. An optional Descriptive Tag may accompany the Fair Entry Tag providing specific detailed information about the entry for the judge's consideration.
7. Crafters may enter in either non-professional or professional division. Crafters who regularly sell their work or teach the craft are considered professional – indicate with a "P" or "NP" on your entry form.

**Class I: Woodworking**

Lots:

- A. Turning
- B. Hand Carving
  1. Three-dimensional
  2. Bas Relief
- C. Cabinet Work
  1. Plain
  2. Inlaid and/or Lamination
- D. Furniture
  1. Chairs, tables, etc.
  2. Boxes and chests
- E. Other

Wood-burning, toys, musical instruments, marine, housewares, implements, etc.

**Class II: Jewelry**

Advise judge with note attached to entry if beads used in jewelry are made by exhibitor.

Lots:

- A. Bracelets
- B. Necklaces
- C. Earrings
- D. Other

**Class III: Basketry**

Lots:

1. Natural (gathered) material
2. Commercial (purchased) materials

**Class IV: Functional Ceramics**

Dishes, vases, candle holders, boxes, etc.

Lots:

- A. Hand-built
- B. Thrown
- C. Mold

**Class V: Glass Craft**

Lots:

- A. Stained
- B. Etched
- C. Fused
- D. Blown
- E. Other

**Class VI: Mosaics**

Made of glass, ceramic tile, seeds, rocks or combination of materials.

**Class VII: Dolls**

Lots:

- A. Porcelain
- B. Cloth
- C. Other

**Class VIII: Decorative or Tole Painting**

Lots:

- A. On wood
- B. On metal
- C. Other

**Class IX: Metal Craft**

**Class X: Other Crafts**

Lots:

- A. Shell Art
- B. Lapidary
- C. Other
